GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA

KidSport Greater Victoria is in its ninth year of providing support to kids in sport in the Capital Regional District. Funds raised locally help financially disadvantaged families with sport and physical activity registration fees. This grant funding program has traditionally been accessed more by males than females. KidSport Greater Victoria (www.kidsportvictoria.ca) and ProMOTION Plus for Girls and Women in Sport and Physical Activity have partnered to create greater opportunity for female athletes.

ProMOTION Plus Co-Chairs Patti Hunter and Joan Wharf Higgins remark “We are excited about this opportunity to assist a traditionally under-served segment of children. According to the 2008 Canadian Community Health Survey, girls between the ages of 12 - 19 are less active than boys, with 60% of girls considered to be at least moderately active as compared to 78% of boys. The long term health benefits of being physically active include a healthier self image, reduced likelihood of depression, disordered eating, smoking, alcohol/substance use, diabetes and osteoporosis. The benefits are enormous and the cost minimal – just a commitment to equitable access to resources for both girls and boys.”

Fair Play Award (Girls aged 10 - 14 years)

- Females aged 10 - 14 years residing in the Capital Regional District are eligible for the award.
- Awarded to an athlete for dedication, determination and fair play.
- \$250 award to be used to attend a training clinic or camp or other form of athletic or leadership training. Equipment, travel to playoffs or tournaments, uniforms, club fundraising fees etc. are not eligible expenses.
- In the application, applicants must demonstrate a sustained sport experience (a season of sport led by a qualified coach) and the sport activity must be affiliated with a sport governing body.
- Duration of award is June 2010 to May 2011.
- Upon completion of clinic/camp/workshop the award recipient must submit a summary of the experience including a rating of the clinic/camp/workshop to ProMOTION Plus Victoria (phunter@promotionplus.org).
- Award cheque will be payable to the recipient’s parent or guardian.
- Recipients will be announced in June 2010 at a ProMOTION Plus event.
